

BYLAW NO. 12-2005

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PENSE NO. 160
TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF
WATER FOR THE HAMLETS OF KEYSTOWN AND STONY BEACH

WHEREAS the Council may regulate the distribution and use of water in the municipality and may fix the price for the use thereof and the times of payment;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the municipality's water supply system shall make application to the officials of the municipality. Each application shall be responsible for providing their own water meter.
2. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of a user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties; fees, rates, charges and arrears have been paid.
3. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set forth in Schedule "A" hereto in as amended from time to time; provided however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
4. Accounts for water service shall cover a period of two successive months, and shall be rendered in the month next following such period (upon the Municipality's receipt of the City of Regina water invoice). Accounts shall be paid within a period of 30 days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If an account is not paid within the said period of 30 days, the water service may be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$50.00 to cover the expense of turning off the water and turning it on again.
5. If at the end of the fiscal year, a bill is still outstanding it will be added to and thereby form a part of the taxes on the land or buildings of the registered owner and the Municipality's Bylaw to Establish a Penalty on Tax Arrears will apply.

The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval thereof being issued by the Local Government Committee.

1. Bi-Monthly Water Charges:

The greater of: Minimum \$11.00

or

An amount equal to the user’s portion of
the City of Regina water invoice based
on a percentage determined by the user’s
consumption and total consumption for
the period.
